VENDOR Registration Fees starts at \$50 for merchandise; and \$100 per day or \$180 flat rate for food & beverages per booth for two days. All payments must in money orders or credit cards, made at least 5 days before the event. Vendor space or vendor services will NOT be assigned unless full payment is made.

Additionally, vendors are allowed to submit giveaway items and advertisements for inclusion in tournament souvenir items. This is a free way to advertise your booth to the teams/spectators attending each event.

This agreement is for space rental only. Vendor Operators are responsible for designing and supplying their own booths. Booths must fit within the space requested including aisles and overhangs if necessary. Booth operations will be restricted to the above described activities or items.

Space is limited and rented on a first-come, first-serve basis.

No refunds will be issued within 30 days of the event.



Deposit must be received along with this application form, and a copy of your **liability insurance** must be received in person or by mail before a space is assigned.

The Community Cup USA and the tournament's host reserve the right to control or halt any activities of any operator for any violation of the rules and regulations of booth operations and respective venue policies. The Booth Operator and authorized personnel agree that they have read, understood; and will comply with the enclosed rules and regulations for booth space operations as evidenced by the operator's signature below.

Rules and Regulations for Booth Operations

1. Each operator should please return the following items:
 - a. A completed and signed application
 - b. A money order in the amount of booth rental fee made out to **Community Cup USA** as specified above.
 - c. Please return all required items at least 5 days prior to the tournament starting date to the address listed above. No refunds will be given after this date.
2. Each Vendor operator will be assigned a location. Operators are responsible for designing and supplying their own booths as this agreement applies to rental space only.
3. Driving a vehicle on any grassy area is strictly prohibited without permission.
4. **All booths should be set up at least one day and/ or by Saturday morning before 9:30 AM** on the day of the event. Reserved space may be released and filled if not checked in/NO show, by then and no refund will be issued.
5. The following is not tolerated at the event site:
 - a. Smoking, excluding designated areas.
 - b. Pets, excluding service pets
 - c. Firearms or weapons of any kind, excluding event's security and local police
 - d. Alcoholic beverages, excluding organizer privileges
6. All booths must be freestanding, no stakes or guidelines unless pre-approved by Community Cup USA officials or the tournament hosting organization.
7. The Community Cup USA and the tournament hosting organization reserve the rights to restrict exhibitors with respect to methods of operation and display of materials. Entertainment or music shall be confined to inside the booth. The Community Cup USA and the tournament hosting organization



reserve the rights to close any booth without refund if they determine the booth interrupts adjoining booths or the tournament in general. If, for any reason, an exhibit or its contents is deemed objectionable by The Community Cup USA officials or the tournament hosting organization, the exhibit will be removed from the grounds without refund. **All decisions by the Community Cup USA Directors or the tournament hosting organization is final.**

8. Limited security is provided during and after tournament hours. The Community Cup USA and the tournament hosting organization will not be responsible for any damage, theft or loss to Vendor's goods and/or properties.

8b. Vendor Operators must secure and maintain liability insurance for the duration of the tournament.

9. **Operators may be banned from this event and future tournaments if:**

a. The Vendor operators misrepresent the category their booth falls under;

b. The vendor operator misrepresents or changes the items sold without notifying The Community Cup USA Officials or tournament hosting organization;

c. The operator or authorized members conduct is detrimental to the best interests of the community cup USA tournament and concert event;

d. The operator violates any the rules or regulations of the tournament.

10. No dangerous or messy merchandise may be sold, i.e. knives, etc.

11. No generator will be allowed without prior consent of The Community Cup USA Directors or the tournament hosting organization.

12. No raffles or games of chance will be permitted except by community cup USA or the tournament hosting organization.

13. All operators are responsible for the collection of sales tax where and when applicable.

14. Operators cannot sell or give their spaces to another operator without the permission of the Community Cup USA Officials or tournament hosting organization.


15. Operators guarantee that all information provided in the application for booth space is true and correct. Operators agree that the Community Cup USA directors or the tournament hosting organization may revoke all of the booth space rights of the booth operator and their authorized personnel without refund of any application fees upon violating of the rules set forth.

16. Operators and authorized personnel agree to hold harmless and indemnify the Community Cup USA, its affiliates and the tournament hosting organization, its committees, officers, agents, employees, and representatives, the owner of the area in which the tournament is being held; from any claims, including theft, damage, loss or injuries, of any kind.

17. Operators concur that they have read and understood the rules and regulations outlined herein; and it is agreed that these rules are part of this contract and no other agreements whether verbal or written, implied or expressed, shall be binding upon the parties unless in
